Just as many healthcare professionals use MRI's, mammograms or X-rays to aid in diagnosing medical conditions, our office provides a comparable level of quality care with digital retinal photos. The photo is quick, easy and comfortable and allows a detailed view of the inner lining of the eye often without the need of dilation.

We generally recommend a baseline photo for every patient to be followed periodically with updated photos for further evaluation. If you have a personal or family history of high blood pressure, diabetes, macular degeneration, glaucoma, retinal holes or detachments we strongly recommend fundus photos.

Most insurance companies do not cover the \$38 fee of routine retinal photos, therefore you will be responsible.

Dilated Eye Exam

It may be necessary to dilate your pupils for a complete evaluation of the retina. If the doctor determines that dilation is required, and it is not possible on the day of your exam, you may be asked to return another day. There is no added charge or billing for this procedure.

After dilation you may experience mild blurring and light sensitivity for several hours. If you do not feel comfortable driving while dilated, you may want to arrange a driver . If you find yourself dilated, and don't have a driver, the Griffin Optometric Group will make arrangements to get you to your destination.
